## Parts Included in Package:

<b>A</b> Galley Rail Back 	<b>B</b> 2 x Galley Rail Side 	
<b>C</b> Foot 	<b>D</b> 4 x Allen Head Bolt 	<b>E</b> 4 x Nylon Washer 
<b>F</b> Allen Wrench 	<b>G</b> 6 x Wood Screw 	<b>H</b> 4 x Shelf Tabs 
<b>I</b> 4 x Felt Pads 	<b>J</b> Shelf 	<b>K</b> Angled Bracket 

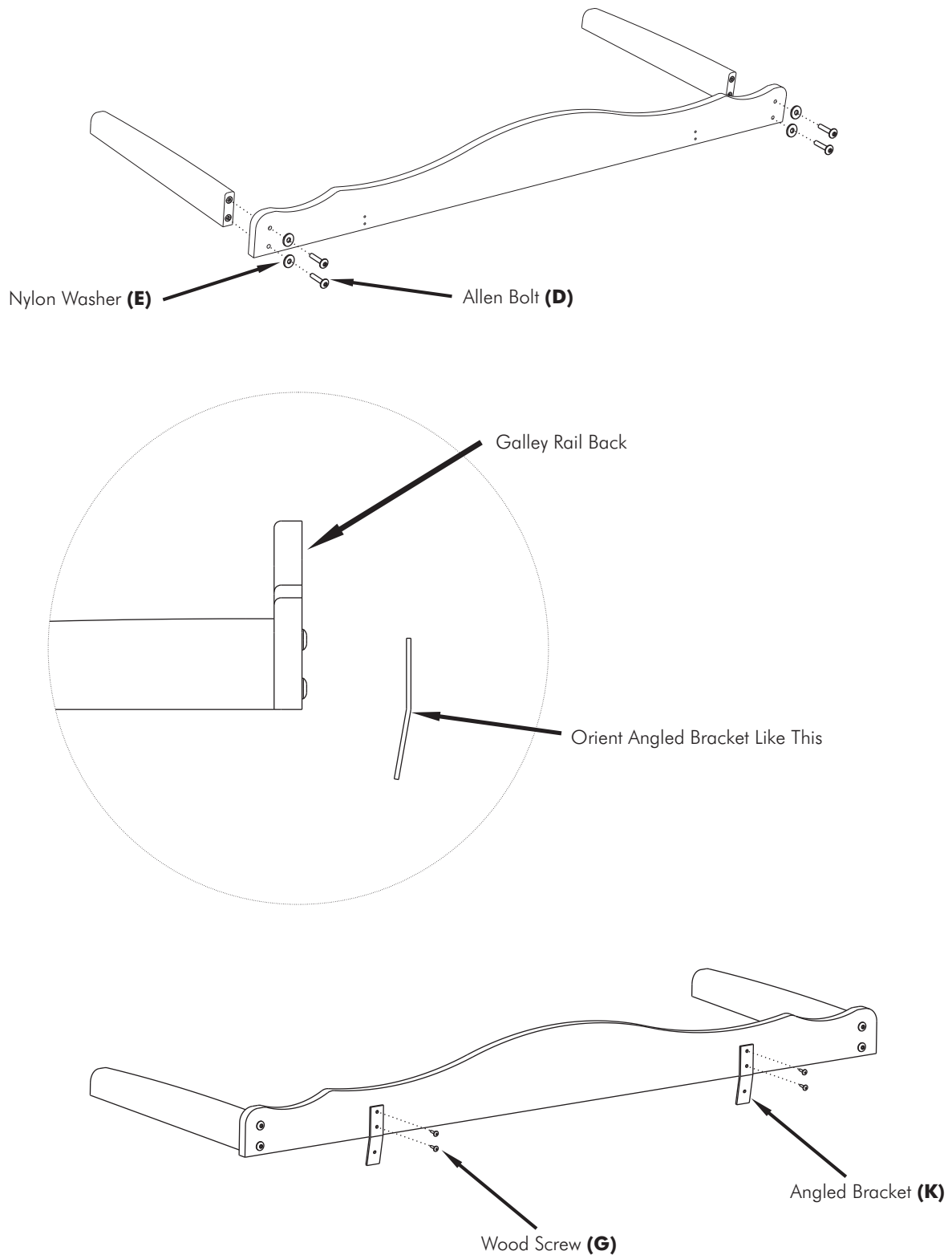
## Step 1

- A.** Unpack all the components from the packaging.  
The feet are located inside the combo.
- B.** Screw the feet into the base.



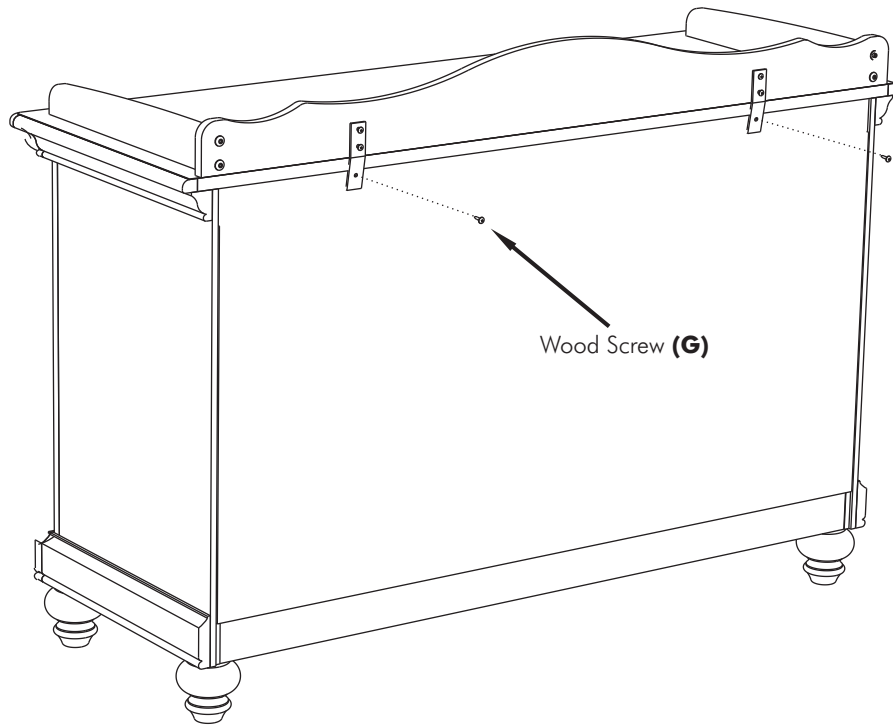
## Step 2

- A.** Align the holes in the galley rail sides (B) with the holes in the galley rail back (A).
- B.** Place a nylon washer (E) onto a bolt (D), then thread it through the hole. Tighten securely using the allen wrench. Do not overtighten. Repeat for the other hole.
- C.** Repeat for the other galley rail side.
- D.** Attach the angled brackets (K) to the back of the galley rail by screwing the wood screws (G) into the pre-drilled holes. The brackets must be attached so that the angle points in the direction shown.



## Step 3

Center the galley rail on the top, then screw the wood screws (G) through the holes on the brackets and into the combo. The screws should go into the panel below the top. There are no pre-drilled holes in the combo, but the wood screws will self tap into the wood with the use of a moderate amount of force applied while turning the screw.



## Step 4

- A.** Stick the felt pads (I) onto the shelf tabs (H) so the tabs don't scratch the shelf.
- B.** Insert the shelf tabs into the holes on the inside of the door, and carefully lower the shelf (J) onto the tabs.
- C.** If desired, you can screw wood screws through the holes in the bottom of the shelf tabs into the bottom of the shelf to prevent the shelf from being accidentally removed.
