## **Assembly Instructions** **Meadowdale Dressing Combo**

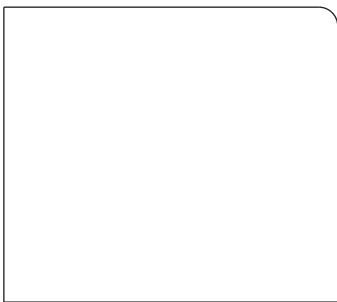
**A** Galley Rail Back



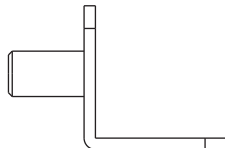
**B** 2 x Galley Rail Side



**C** Shelf



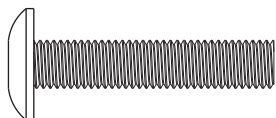
**D** 4 x Shelf Tab



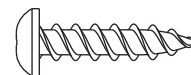
**E** 4 x Removable Foot



**F** 4 x Phillips Head Bolt

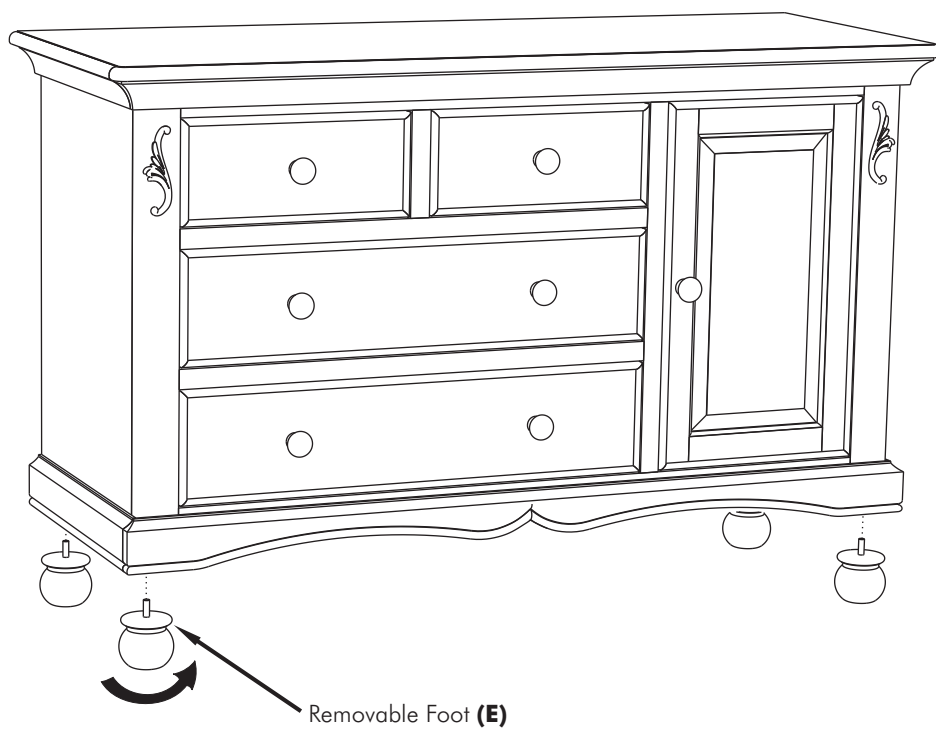


**G** 4 x Wood Screw



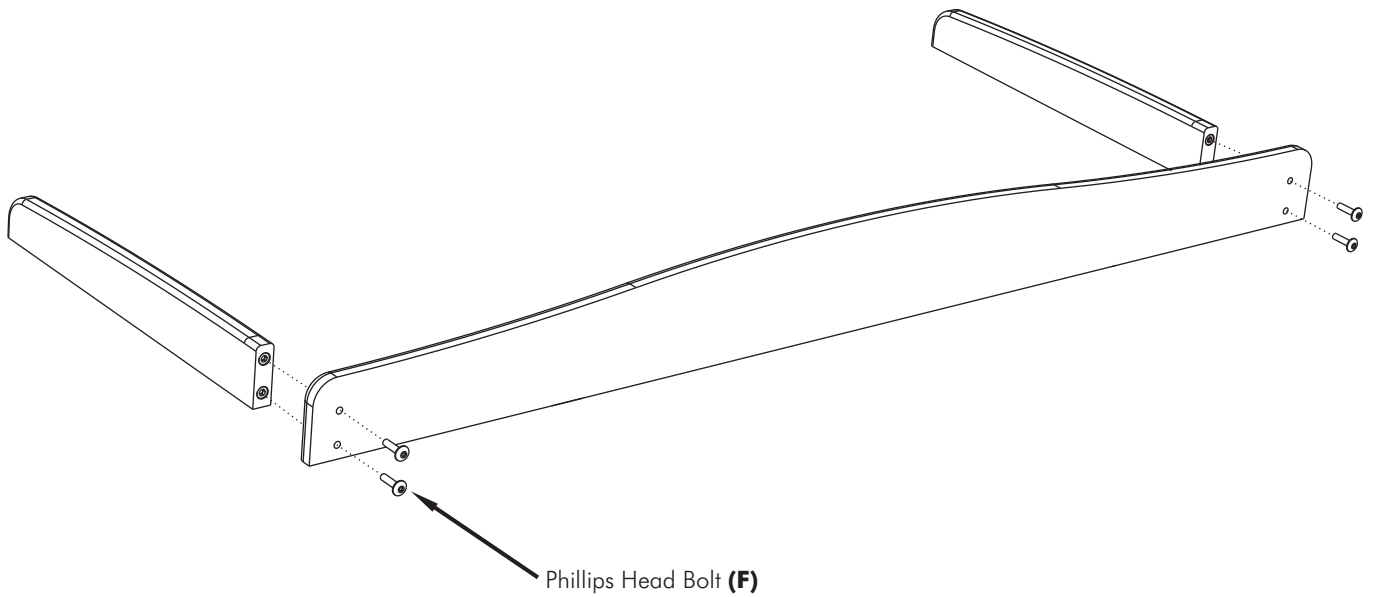
## Step 1

- A.** Unpack all the components from the packaging.  
The feet are located in the top left drawer.
- B.** Screw the removable feet into the base.



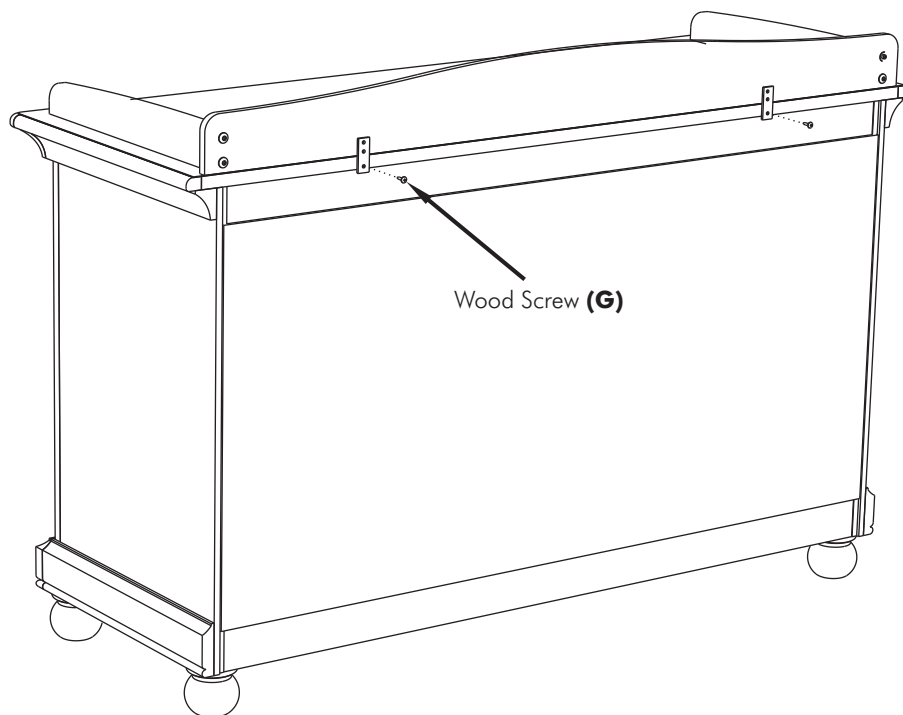
## Step 2

- A.** Align the holes in the galley rail sides (B) with the holes in the galley rail back (A).
- B.** Thread a bolt (F) through the hole. Tighten securely using a phillips head screwdriver, and repeat for the other hole.
- C.** Repeat for the other side.



## Step 3

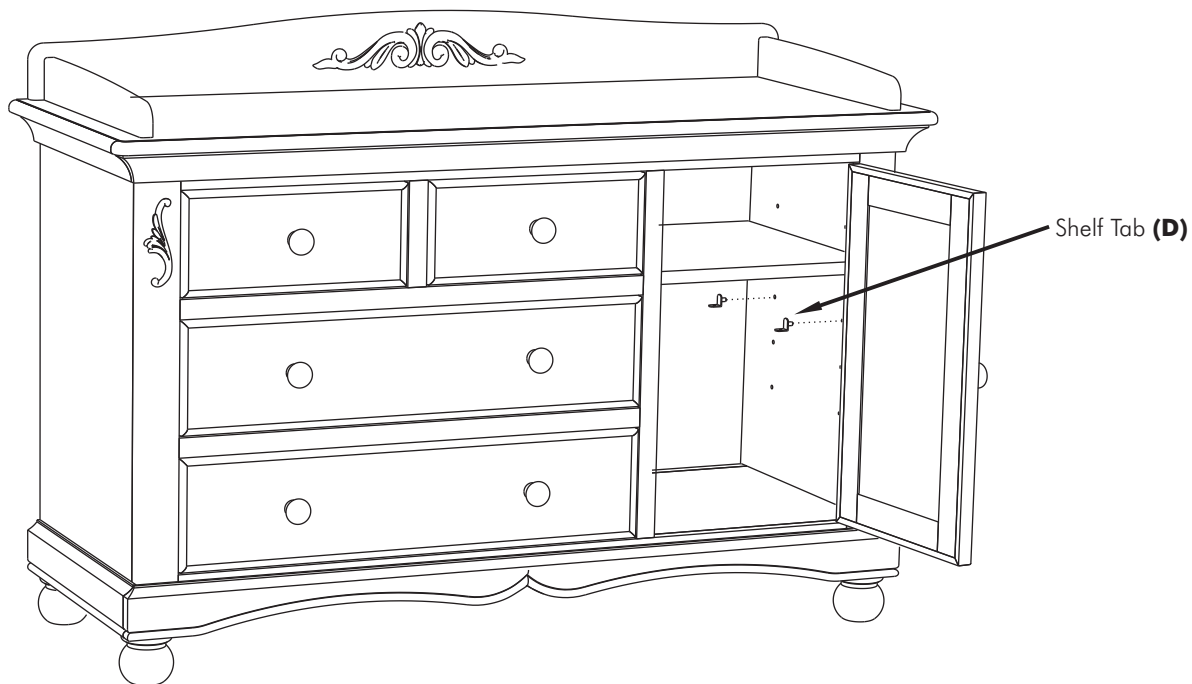
- A.** If you are using a changing pad, secure it to the combo using the straps as instructed by the pad manufacturer.
- B.** Center the galley rail on the top, then screw the wood screws (G) through the holes on the mounting plates and into the combo.



## Step 4

**A.** Insert the shelf tabs (D) into the holes on the inside of the door, and carefully lower the shelf (C) onto the tabs.

**B.** If desired, you can screw  $\frac{1}{2}$ " long wood screws (not included) through the holes in the bottom of the shelf tabs into the bottom of the shelf to prevent the shelf from being accidentally removed.
